


BY THE NUMBERS FY 2021-2022

The S.C. Sea Grant Consortium, an independent state agency, is a federal-state partnership which supports integrated research, extension, and education programs to achieve its mission. One of 34 university-based programs located across the United States, Consortium efforts provide for future economic opportunities, improve the social well-being of citizens, and ensure wise use and development of marine and coastal natural resources.

Economic Opportunity

- **\$9,629,613** economic benefit
- 14 coastal businesses created or sustained
- 170 jobs created or sustained
- **236** attendees trained by the Calling the Coast Home Realtor Training Program received 472 continuing education credits across 7 sessions, providing an economic benefit of \$16,407.

Coastal Resilience

- **79** trainings to improve coastal community resilience
- **5** communities implemented sustainable development practices and plans

Education & Workforce Development



- 10,768 P-12 students reached
- **427** teachers trained and 13 of 46 counties engaged
- 26 graduate students and fellows supported
- 18 undergraduate students supported

- 5,142 volunteer hours completed
- \$28.54/hr for volunteers
- \$160,538 value of volunteer time
